Bus Stop area at Oak Tree stores: Highways have done the road. D. Lugton undertook to obtain quotes for pavement area from, Skinners; P J Alfrey; Krusel hedge, this has been cut but still needs more removed from road side section of hedge for good sight line.

Signs re Pedestrians Dunsfold Road, Fiona Baker (Highways) pushing for these signs to be up as soon as possible and before the clock changes. Bibs for the children/parent who walk the road were gratefully accepted.

Hedge on first bend out of village towards Dunsfold; it was felt this was coming out onto road reducing sight lines, also opposite (football ground) Hedge could do with trimming.


